The Technical Committee of the European PET Bottle Platform (EPBP) was requested to assess the effect of the APTAR Simplicycle closure on the quality of recycled PET. The application refers to a High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) closure that includes a floatable Thermoplastic elastomer (TPE) dispensing valve.

Based on the outcome of the EPBP assessment and current market knowledge in 2021, the European PET Bottle Platform (EPBP) concludes that Aptar's Simplicycle closure will not have an impact on current European PET Recycling processes. EPBP have awarded an endorsement of the Simplicycle closure.
